> Dear Mr. Kazocins,

>

> I received a call today from a friend who also used to have an important job at Parex Bank.

>

> It seems that he has been talking with someone high-up at Parex Bank about me and understands that I am in a jam because I have accused Parex Bank of accounting fraud and I have accused the Prosecutor's Office and FKTK of being accomplices to the fraud since they are refusing to commence prosecution.

>

> This friend asked me what it is that I want from Parex Bank, indicating that he could be a go-between in any talk between me and Parex since he was concerned for me.

>

> It is possible that Parex asked him to negotiate an amount of money that Parex Bank could give me in exchange for me shutting up about Parex, but I am not sure about that. I do believe that one of my other former colleagues at Parex Bank got such a deal, because former Managing Director Dainis Barups was transferred out of Latvia to receive a salary for doing no work during 2003 and I believe this was most likely payment to keep him silent about whatever he knew about the relationship between Parex and Latvenergo (Karlis Mikelsons) and/or Parex and the National Treasury (Aivars Veiss).

> I told my friend that I do not want any money from Parex and I will not retract the letter that I provided to the Prosecutor last year and I am happy to stay far away from Latvia and I do not want to make any

> further problems for anyone and what I hope Parex will do is just
> leave me alone.
>
> My friend said that he will call someone at Parex and try to negotiate
> a peace between us and said that I may receive a call from someone at
> the Prosecutor's Office to make a settlement.
>
> Of course the implication that the Prosecutor's Office will call me to
> make a "settlement" between me and Parex Bank is that the Prosecutor's
> Office might call me to say that I will be prosecuted for some
> make-believe reason unless I retract the letter that I provided to the
> Prosecutor's Office.
>
> It is also possible that if someone from the Prosecutor's Office calls
> me, they will try to get me to reveal the name of the lawyer in the
> Prosecutor's Office from whom I learned that Parex was paying bribes.
>
> Is it possible for the Constitutional Protection Bureau to have my
> mobile phone recorded in case I receive such a call? My LMT number is
> 946 1959.
>
> Or, do you have any better recommendation for me, since I am terrified
> of talking to someone from the Prosecutor's Office? Maybe I should
> just turn off my phone or have it forwarded to one of my lawyers? I
> am afraid to communicate by email with either Parex Bank or the
> Prosecutor's Office since they can trace where I am from an email.
>
> Also I would be extremely interested to know if anyone is actually
> doing anything about the frauds. For example, I would be interested
> to know if Parex has been pressured to change auditors and undergo a
> forensic audit.
